FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 15 new cases of COVID-19. There are currently 29 active cases of COVID-19 in the county.

New cases include three females under the age of 19, two males under the age of 19, two females age 30-39, two females age 40-39, two males age 40-49, one female age 50-59, one female age 70-79 and two males age 70-79. Six cases are community spread, seven cases are school related and two cases are travel related.

At the time of this press release, the following reflects COVID-19 in Macon County -

- 29 active positive cases
- 1 hospitalized (included in the active case count)
- 178 released from isolation
- 207 total positive cases

The state of Missouri reports 118,311 positive cases of COVID-19.
