FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 58 new cases of COVID-19 in the county since the last press release on Friday November 13, 2020. Currently, the county has 145 active positive cases.

New cases include: three males under age 19, four females under age 19, three males age 20-29, five females age 20-29, one male age 30-39, two females age 30-39, three males age 40-49, six females age 40-49, one male age 50-59, six females age 50-59, three males age 60-69, two females age 60-69, five males age 70-79, six females age 70-79, two males age 80-89, two females age 80-89, two females age 90, one female over the age of 100 and one positive of an unknown age.

The following reflects cases as of the end of the day on November 15, 2020 in Macon County –

- 145 active positive cases
- 9 hospitalized (included in the active case count)
- 9 deaths
- 454 released from isolation
- 608 total positive cases
