(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 55 new cases of COVID-19. Currently, there are 148 active cases in the county.

New cases include two males under 19, five females under 19, two males age 20-29, eight females age 20-29, one male age 30-39, three females age 30-39, one male age 40-49, four females age 40-49, three males age 50-59, seven females age 50-59, one male age 60-69, seven females age 60-69, two males age 70-79, one female age 70-79, four males age 80-89, one female age 80-89, two males over age 90 and one female over age 90.

Sadly, we are announcing an additional death of a Macon County resident due to COVID-19. Our thoughts and prayers go out to the family and friends of this resident.

The following is accurate as of the end of the day on November 17, 2020 -

- 148 active cases (in isolation)
- 7 hospitalized (included in the active case count)
- 10 deaths
- 505 released from isolation
- 663 total positive cases
