(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 39 new cases of COVID-19 since Monday’s press release. Currently, the county has 71 active cases.

We are saddened to announce three more deaths of Macon County residents. One was from May of a resident at an out of county nursing home that was just reported to us by DHSS. Our thoughts and prayers go out to the family and friends of these residents.

New cases include six females under the age of 19, two males under the age of 19, four males age 20-29, four females age 30-39, four females age 40-49, four males age 40-49, seven females age 50-59, two males age 60-69, three females age 60-69, two males age 70-79 and one male age 80-89.

As of the end of the day on November 4th, the following reflects cases of COVID-19 in Macon County –

- 71 active cases
- 9 hospitalized (included in the active case count)
- 5 deaths
- 320 released from isolation
- 396 total cases

The state of Missouri currently reports 196,576 total positive cases of COVID-19.
