FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 21 new cases of COVID-19 in Macon County. Ten new cases were received on December 16th and 11 new cases were received on December 17th.

One case that was announced on the December 16th press release is being retracted. After further investigation, it was determined the person was not a resident of Macon County.

New cases include: two males under 19, one female age 20-29, two females age 30-39, two males age 40-49, two females age 40-49, three males age 50-59, two females age 50-59, one male age 60-69, two females age 60-69 and four females age 70-79.

The following reflects cases of COVID-19 in Macon County as of the end of the day on December 17, 2020 –

- 72 active positive cases
- 7 hospitalized
- 19 deaths
- 940 released from isolation
- 1,031 total positive cases
