(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 23 new cases of COVID-19 in Macon County. These cases were received between January 7, 2021 and January 10, 2021.

New cases include two males age 19 or under, one female age 19 or under, two males age 20-29, three females age 20-29, four males age 30-39, two females age 30-39, one male age 40-49, two females age 40-49, two males age 50-59, two females age 50-59, one male age 60-69 and one male age 70-79.

The following reflects COVID-19 in Macon County as of the end of the day on January 10, 2021-

- 92 active cases
- 4 hospitalized
- 19 deaths
- 1,098 released from isolation
- 1,209 total positive cases
