FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 55 new cases of COVID-19 in the county. 30 cases were received on January 21st, nine cases were received on January 22nd, 11 cases were received on January 23rd and five cases were received on January 24th.

New cases include four females age 19 and under, three males age 20-29, six females age 20-29, one male age 30-39, five females age 30-39, four males age 40-49, one female age 40-49, one female age 50-59, three males age 60-69, one female age 60-69, three males age 70-79, 11 females age 70-79, three males age 80-89, four females age 80-89, one male age 90-99, two females age 90-99 and one male and one female of unknown age.

The following reflects COVID-19 in Macon County as of the end of the day on January 24, 2021-

- 100 active cases
- 10 hospitalized
- 19 deaths
- 1,256 released from isolation
- 1,375 total positive cases
