### FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 42 new cases of COVID-19 received December 30, 2020 – January 4, 2021.

New cases include four males age 19 and under, one female age 19 and under, one male 20-29, three females age 20-29, two males age 30-39, four females age 30-39, one male age 40-49, six females age 40-49, one male age 50-59, three females age 50-59, two males age 60-69, two females age 60-69, three males age 70-79, six females age 70-79, one female age 80-89, and two males age 90-99.

Macon County has now seen reinfections where people who have tested positive in the past and getting it again. It is important that if you have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past, you should continue to take precautions especially after your 90 days of immunity. We are unsure at this time how hard it impacts the health of those that are reinfected.

The following reflects cases of COVID-19 as of the end of the day on January 4, 2021 –

- 54 active positive cases
- 5 hospitalized
- 19 deaths
- 1,075 released from isolation
- 1,148 total positive cases
