(Macon County, MO) – The Macon County Health Department announces 38 new cases of COVID-19 in Macon County. 14 new cases were received January 5th and 24 new cases were received January 6th.

New cases include four males under 19, four females under 19, five males age 20-29, four females age 20-29, two males age 30-39, four females age 30-39, two males age 40-49, two females age 40-49, three males age 50-59, two females age 50-59, one male age 60-69, three females age 60-69 and two females age 70-79.

The following reflects COVID-19 cases in Macon County as of the end of the day on January 6, 2021 –

- 87 active cases
- 5 hospitalizations
- 19 deaths
- 1,080 released from isolation
- 1,186 total positive cases

Macon County is beginning to see a rise in cases since the holiday season. There has also been instances where people have become reinfected with COVID-19 after their 90 day immunity period. It is important to continue taking precautions to help slow the spread of COVID-19, even if you have already had COVID-19. Wear a mask over your mouth and nose when you are around others. Practice social distancing of at least 6 feet between yourself and others not in your household. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water and clean frequently touched objects.
