FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Macon County, MO) – Macon County residents continue to be vaccinated. To date per DHSS dashboard, 5,429 vaccines have been given to residents: 3,297 initial doses and 2,147 completed 2-dose series (1 unaccounted for dose). Currently, 21.8% of the population have had at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. Macon County Health Department and Samaritan Hospital continue to partner to provide vaccination clinics targeted toward the Phase 1 population.

Macon County is continuing to see new cases of COVID-19 with the virus actively spreading within the community. Over the week of March 25-March 30, Macon County had 21 new cases of COVID-19 in the county with ages ranging from child to elderly adult. We caution residents to be diligent with mitigation measures to curb this increase – social distance where possible and mask when not able to distance.
