(Macon County, MO) – Macon County residents continue to be vaccinated as vaccines become available and statewide eligibility opens up. To date per DHSS dashboard, 6,055 vaccines have been given to residents: 3,448 initial doses and 2,662 completed 2-dose series (1 unaccounted for dose). Currently, 22.8% of the population have had at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. Macon County Health Department and Samaritan Hospital continue to partner to provide vaccination clinics to help vaccinate the residents of Macon County.

Over the week of March 31 – April 6, 2021, there were 26 new cases of COVID-19 in Macon County. The Macon County Health Department continues to encourage mitigation techniques to prevent the community transmission of COVID-19 through social distancing and wearing mask.

The following reflects COVID-19 in Macon County as of the end of the day on April 6, 2021 -

- 25 active cases
- 3 hospitalized
- 15 deaths
- 1,580 total positive cases
