(Macon County, MO) – During the week of July 28 – August 3, 2021, there were 63 new cases of COVID-19. Currently, there are 65 active cases with 2 residents hospitalized. Of these 63 new cases, 16 were vaccinated with none of these vaccinated in the hospital, and, no new cases were reinfection. Of the last 303 cases, 271 were not vaccinated. There were 152 positive cases in July which was 67% more than June and almost 3-1/2 times more than May.

Of the 63 positive cases, 13 were under 19 years of age; 16 in their 20's; 7 in their 30's; 10 in their 40's; 6 in their 50's; 7 in their 60's; 4 in their 70's; and none in their 80's. Most of this week's new cases are in Macon city (36 cases), Anabel (4 cases), Atlanta (9 cases), Bevier (2 cases), Callao (1 case), La Plata (6 cases), Excello (1 case), New Cambria (2 cases), Bucklin (1 case), Marceline address in Macon County (1 case).

Most of our cases this past week were in younger adults most who were unvaccinated. COVID-19 vaccine is a choice. Macon County Health Department continues to give the Johnson & Johnson and the Moderna vaccines weekly in our office with clinics Wednesday's and Thursday's. The health department nurses are knowledgeable about the vaccines and want to provide information for an educated choice either to vaccinate or not. Call the Macon County Health Department to speak to one of the nurses or to schedule an appointment.

The following reflects COVID-19 in Macon County as of the end of the day on August 3, 2021 –

- 65 active cases
- 2 hospitalized
- 19 deaths
- 1,901 total cases since March 2020
