FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

(Macon County, MO) – During the week of November 24-30, we increased to 81 new cases of COVID-19, compared to 40 last week, 32 the week before, 29 the week before, and 31 reported the first week in November. Currently, there are 94 active cases with 9 residents hospitalized. Of these 81 new cases, 11 were vaccinated which includes 2 of the hospitalized, and, there were no new cases of reinfection. Of the last 903 cases, 764 were not vaccinated.

Of the 81 positive cases, 13 were under 19 years of age; 19 in their 20’s; 14 in their 30’s; 11 in their 40’s; 5 in their 50’s; 8 in their 60’s; 9 in their 70’s; 2 in their 80’s; and, 0 in their 90’s. Most of this week’s new cases are in Macon city (31 cases), Anabel (1 case), Atlanta (6 cases), Bevier (18 case), Bucklin (2 cases), Callao (4 cases), Elmer (0 cases), Ethel (0 case), Excello (5 cases), La Plata (9 cases), and, New Cambria (5 cases).

The Macon County Health Department offers Moderna, Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccines weekly in their office. If planning to get a second or booster dose of Moderna, Pfizer or Johnson & Johnson, it is important to bring your vaccine card to determine eligibility and to update your record. Everyone ages 18 and older are now eligible for a booster dose for all three COVID-19 vaccines. The health department nurses are knowledgeable about vaccines and can help you determine booster dose eligibility. Samaritan Hospital provides vaccine for children 5-12, and, the hospital and health department are offering all adult doses by appointment.

The following reflects COVID-19 in Macon County as of the end of the day on November 30, 2021 –

- 94 active cases
- 9 hospitalized
- 22 deaths (DHSS dashboard only reflects 20) plus 14 probable deaths listed by DHSS (antigen tested)
- 2,501 total cases since March 2020
